He wrote this about his family history: "As near as we know, the first Nation names at the Church of the Resurrection parish would have been Clarence and Mary Nation in about 1909. Mary was a cradle Catholic with the Blackshaw maiden name and connections to the Whitehead family. Both of those family names date back to the early to mid 1800's. Clarence and Mary's three children, John, Frances and Clarena would have been students at the Resurrection parish school in the early 1900's, which was later converted to the present day church. John, in the mid 1930's, married Virginia Grennan of the Immaculate Conception Parish in Montgomery City. To John and Virginia were born 6 children, John, Joseph Jr., Joan (Garufi), Don, Richard, Mary (Gooch) and Robert."
