The St. Joseph School Advisory Board met in regular session on October 25, 2017 at 6:00. Jeffrey Schafer called the meeting to order and Brook Poindexter led the opening prayer. Also in attendance were Becky Hoyt, Jeff Fennewald, Coty Cope, and Michelle Hombs. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

Committee Reports

Athletics- (Aaron) Practices are going well. There are eleven games scheduled. The first game is Thursday, October 26. There will be a pep rally that day beginning at 2:30.

Early Learning Center- (Coty) Looking into the possibility of a deep cleaning at the Early Learning Center. Also, need to put more rock down in the playground area.

Extended Care- (Coty) The number of students attending extended care is up. There is a new high school student who is going to help and will start on Monday.

Parents as First Educators- (Brook) This is going well. The parents are still using the same Seeds and Promise program that has been used in the past. Advent Activity Night is December 5.

Maintenance- (Jeffrey) School roof is leaking in two locations. Working with Father and Brenda on how to proceed with repairs. A hinge in the girls' bathroom needs to be fixed. LED lights still need to be completed in the library, north side of basement, Mrs. Kuda's room, bathrooms and hallway by 3-8 grade classrooms. Also need to finish floors and countertops and hang pictures in the library. Would like to schedule a work day in November to complete or possibly a day in December. January 15 and 16 is the scheduled winter school cleaning.

Technology- Need to work on WiFi for the classrooms. Will talk with Alsat about a quote. The library computers still need to be hooked up.

Recruitment- (Becky) The Crusader Connection newsletter has been published twice now. We have received lots of good feedback on this. We hope to publish it again before the end of the semester. Also, need to locate the recruitment banner so we can put it up again in the spring.

Financial – (Jeff) We would like to work again with Finance Council on teacher contracts and would like to get this done early this school year for planning for the upcoming year.

Principal's Report – We are in need of a school custodian. This person would need to work 12 to 15 hours a week.

Pastor's Report – No report.

Old Business – We donated two “free school cleanings” to the Oktoberfest auction. The school board and faculty social was held on October 10 in the school basement before the Home and School meeting. Funeral flowers were sent for Mr. Struck's memorial service.

New Business- We need to review the self-study for any items that still need to be addressed.
