

## 2016-2017 STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

**General Guidelines:** *There is no need to purchase new supplies each year as many are designed for multiple years of use.*

**No** colored paper or notebooks.

**No** "perfect-edge notebooks" (they fall apart)

**Only wide-line** paper and notebooks, please.

Book bag should hold both books and papers.

**Parents are to ensure that students have adequate supplies ALL YEAR!!**

### Kindergarten

12 pencils – plain #2 **SHARPENED** (do not label with name)

\*1 large eraser

\*Crayola WASHABLE markers – classic colors

\*Backpack (no wheels)

### Grades 1-2

24 pencil cap erasers (pencil toppers) [do not label with name]

12 #2 plain pencils (do not label with name)

\*Large eraser (not novelty)

\*Crayons (no more than 24)

\*Markers – washable

2 pack thin, dry erase markers (black or blue preferred)

\*Watercolor paints

\*Scissors

\*School Box (regular size "Spacemaker") or zipper pencil bag (crayons, markers, scissors must fit inside)

\*3 folders with two pockets and three prongs – plastic preferred

1 **yellow** 2 pocket folder (**not plastic**) [**for religion**]

1<sup>st</sup> Grade only: 1 **blue** 2 pocket folder (**not plastic**) [**for Language Arts**]

\*2 spiral notebooks (70 wide-lined pages) **one blue** [**for Language Arts**]

1 wide ruled three subject notebook

2 rolls paper towels

2 boxes Kleenex

1 container anti-bacterial wipes

\*Backpack – no wheels (must fit inside locker which is 10 inches by 11 inches; 34 inches high)

### **Grades 3-4**

- 1 composition book
- 1 scissors
- 24 #2 pencils (do **not** label with name)
- 1 package cap erasers (pencil toppers)
- \*1 large eraser
- \*School box (crayons, markers, and colored pencils must fit)
- \*Crayons – 24 pack **maximum**
- \*Markers
- \*Colored pencils – small box
- Glue sticks – 6 (regular size)
- Liquid glue – 1
- 1 package of wide-ruled loose-leaf paper
- 1-2 pocket folder for desk
- 1 **green** 2 pocket folder (**not plastic**) [**for science**]
- 2 **green** wide ruled one subject notebook [**for science**]
- \*1 3 ring binder (1 ½ inch); zipper works best
- \*1 folder with two pockets for binder
- \*-70 page notebook (wide line – spiral); third grade needs 2; fourth grade needs 3
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade:** 1 package of 4 dry erase markers (multi-colored)
- 4<sup>th</sup> Grade:** 1 package black sharpies (fine point)
- 2 rolls paper towels
- 2 boxes Kleenex
- 1 container anti-bacterial wipes
- \*Backpack – no wheels (must fit inside locker which is 10 inches by 11 inches; 34 inches high)

### **Grades 5-6**

- Bible (should have the one they received as a third grader)
- \*1 Calculator (scientific recommended but not required)
- \*1 3 ring, loose-leaf binder, (at least 2 inch, sturdy - will be going home every night. Choose wisely so you don't have to purchase another one during the year)

- \*Pencils - #2 lead
- \*1 large eraser
- 1 package cap erasers (pencil toppers)
- \*Blue or black ball point pens, plus one other colored pen
- \*Glue (both liquid and stick)
- \*Crayons
- \*highlighters (3 colors) [**for language arts**]
- \*5 2 pocket folders (**not plastic**) [**for language arts**]
- \*Markers
- \*Colored pencils
- \*Scissors
- White wide-line loose-leaf paper
- \*Zipper pencil case or box
- \*1 folder with pockets
- 1 sketch pad
- 2 rolls paper towels
- 2 boxes Kleenex
- 3 containers Clorox wipes
- \*6 packs 3" x 5" lined index cards (white or colored)
- \*1 pack 3" x 5" lined index cards (white or colored) [**for language arts**]

\*highlighters (3 colors) **[for language arts]**

White wide-line loose-leaf paper (need for English and Math – please have plenty)

\*1 (2 inch) loose-leaf binder (3 rings)

\*Calculator (scientific recommended but not required)

\*Zipper pencil case

1 **black** 2 pocket folder (**not plastic**) **[for computers/art]**

\*5 2 pocket folders (**not plastic**) **[for language arts]**

1 **black** wide ruled one subject notebook**[for computers/art]**

10 subject dividers with tabs

1 sketch pad **[for computers/art]**

1 8GB flash drive

\*5 folders with pockets

\*5 wide-lined one subject notebooks

2 red wide ruled one subject notebooks [ for 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Math]

1 **red** 2 pocket folder (**not plastic**) [ for 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Math]

Graph paper [ for 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Math]
